The Florida Department of Education has named FSWC - Charlotte an A+ school yet again! We are proud to announce that we have been ranked #8 out of Florida's 455 high schools (compared to #13 last year.) FSWC - Charlotte received a total of 1461 points out of a possible 1600, an increase of 32 points over the previous year. This is an incredible feat as the schools ranked above us include highly selective schools, college prep schools, charter schools, and performing arts schools that all have entrance requirements. As you know, FSWC accepts their students entirely at random, based on a lot-

tery. The luck of the draw has proved very successful as FSWC has been named an A+ school all of its five years in existence. We are also very happy to announce that our sister school, FSWC - Lee, also made the top ten, coming in at #5 with a total of 1483 points. This is the first time that FSWC -Lee has ranked above us, but we are very proud of their accomplishments. Furthermore, we would like to congratulate the students here at FSWC for their continued academic excellence and diligence in all that they do. This semester, 21 freshmen, 15 sophomores, 7 juniors, and 5 seniors received straight A's!

Additionally, 30 freshmen, 18 sophomores, 37 juniors, and 18 seniors received A/B honor roll. Keep up the good work, Buccaneers! Finally, we would just like to thank all of FSWC's faculty as well as the parents of the students here. Your continued support and dedication to these children is

what makes this school so special.
